After her double stroke, Yvonne was appointed Executive Manager: Innovation and Editorial. In this role, she supported content houses across various media platforms, which express, celebrate and affirm South African and African stories. Yvonne's passion for weaving and

positioning the African tapestry in a global context represents her quest for making Africa's great stories widely known.

Yvonne's academic qualifications include a Master of Arts (University of Stellenbosch, South Africa), a Materials Development Certificate (Thames Valley University, United Kingdom), Bachelor of Arts Hons (Wits University, South Africa, 1992), a Bachelor of Arts in Education (Honours) (Wits University), Bachelor of Arts with distinction in Education (UNISA, South Africa), a Senior Secondary Teachers Diploma (Soweto College). She has recently obtained a Certificate in Occupationally Directed Education & Training Development Practices – NQF 4 (Maccauvlei Learning Academy). She has worked as a teacher at Kagiso Sr Secondary school and also worked at McMillan Publishers.
